

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL**Sec. 26-1. No person to ride on apparatus.**

No person other than members of the fire department, shall ride or get upon any apparatus of the fire department at, going to or returning from any fire, nor upon any other occasion without permission of the fire chief. Any person violating this section shall, upon conviction be punished as provided in section 1-14.

Secs. 26-2—26-30. Reserved.**ARTICLE II. OPEN BURNING****Sec. 26-31. Burning regulations.**

(a) No fire shall be built or allowed to burn on any street, sidewalk or asphalt pavement.

(b) The burning of anything but leaves shall only be permitted in an incinerator so constructed and used as to prevent the spread of fire by an arresting screen or similar device which prevents the escape of igniting particles or burning material therefrom and such incinerator shall be located on a noncombustible surface.

(c) Any fire or smoke causing a hazard or nuisance must be extinguished.

(d) Burning as specifically mentioned in this section shall be banned except from 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m., year round.

(e) A person who violates any provision of this section is responsible for a municipal civil infraction, subject to payment of a civil fine as set forth in section 1-14. Repeat offenses under this section shall be subject to increased fines as set forth in section 1-14.
